- 1. Verses 1-12 set forth the contrasting "before and after" realities for Jerusalem. What examples can you find in these verses that speak of the vast contrast?
- 2. Despite her privilege, glory and honour, Jerusalem fell. What is the warning sounded forth to nations/churches/individuals? Refer to Proverbs 16:18, Luke 12:48b and 1 Corinthians 10:12.
- 3. People talk a lot about a "fall from grace". Is that a Christian expression? Can a Christian fall from grace? (Can you back up your answer with Scripture?)
- 4. Who was the group of people held accountable for Jerusalem's failings? (v13 & 20). How were these people guilty? (Refer to Jeremiah 6:13-14 and 23:11). What is the warning to people in their position today?
- 5. How does Jesus Christ provide the kind of leadership that we truly need? How does He make up for the failings of each of these 3 offices?
- 6. Why is the nation of Edom mentioned in v21? What were they guilty of? What is the cup that Jeremiah assures them of? Who are we to see today represented by this nation of Edom?
- 7. How does v22 contain good news for Jerusalem? How does it contain good news for us? Refer to John 19:30. What bearing should this have on our lives?
